NKWD's Engineering Manager Wins Award ***AWWA's First Annual Vernon Lucy Award***

Erlanger, KY – On July 10, 2012, the Chair and Trustees of the Engineering & Construction Division of the American Water Works Association (AWWA) announced that Amy Kramer, Northern Kentucky Water District (NKWD) Engineering Design Manager, will be one of two recipients of the first annual Vernon Lucy Award. Amy has been a member of the AWWA Capital Project Delivery Committee since 2004 and is currently serving as Vice Chair. She served as the coordinator for updating the second edition of “American Water Works Association, Manual of Water Supply Practices M47, Capital Project Delivery”. This manual serves as a reference to water utilities and the water industry on the different approaches used to design and build water projects.

The late Vernon Lucy was a long-time AWWA volunteer leader and Water For People supporter who was recognized throughout the water industry. He was an engineering graduate of Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University and served in the US Army in Vietnam. The Vernon Lucy Award recognizes an individual's sustained service or demonstrated creativity, initiative and dedication to the work of the Engineering & Construction Division of the AWWA.

The award will be presented at the Opening General Session of the Distribution Systems Symposium & Exposition in St. Louis in September. Affiliated with the American Water Works Association, this event is a program designed for distribution, engineering and operations professionals.
